Top 1: WP1 Drivers & Pressures

- Status of agricultural management product (task 1.5) (Michael): Current status is available (back to 1969) via ftp site; early product and methodology shall be ready before June.

 - ⇒ Annette will find out about SBSTA hot issues and info needs and will contact Michael
 - ⇒ Draft document should be ready before the annual meeting in Braunschweig
